सूचना और प्रसारण मंत्री (श्री राज बहादुर): (क) जी, हां । फिल्म विभाग के कन्ट्रोलर ने, जिन्होंने बाल फिल्म संस्था द्वारा की गई अनियमितताओं की जांच की थी, अपनी रिपोर्ट सरकार को 15 जुलाई, 1965 को पेश की थी ।

(ख) इस जांच का संक्षिप्त विवरण सभा पटल पर रखा गया है । [पुस्तकालय में रखा गया । देखिए संख्या एल० टी०-5767/66] ।

(ग) बाल फिल्म संस्था की कार्य-कारिणी परिषद् रिपोर्ट पर विचार कर चुकी है । परिषद् ने निदेश दिया है कि संस्था, बसूल न किया जा सकने वाला नुकसान, श्री लिमये से, जो अब संस्था के भ्रूवतनिक कोषाध्यक्ष भी हैं, परामर्श करके, बट्टे खाते में डाल दे । कोषाध्यक्ष की राय में जो नुकसान बसूल किया जा सकता है, और जिसके सम्बन्ध में कानूनी कार्रवाई हो सकती है, उस के बारे में संस्था के मंत्री अपने कानूनी सलाहकारों से मशविरा करें और भ्रूवतनिक कोषाध्यक्ष से सलाह कर के उसकी बसूली के लिये कानूनी कार्रवाई शुरू करें । संस्था इस पर आगे कार्रवाई कर रही है ।

#### Production in Ordnance Factories

2052. Shri S. M. Banerjee: Will the Minister of Defence be pleased to state:

(a) whether production in the Ordnance Factories has gone up in 1965 as compared to that in 1964;

(b) if so, the total value of work done during 1964-65; and

(c) whether more expansion programmes are in hand for 1966?

**The Minister of State in the Ministry of Defence (Shri A. M. Thomas):**

(a) The production in Ordnance Factories in 1965 was somewhat less than that during 1964. The reasons for the reduction were as follows:—

- (i) Bulk of the deficiencies in clothing and general stores were met in 1963 and 1964. The requirement of such items was therefore considerably less in 1965 than in 1964. With this fall in demand, overtime work has been stopped in the clothing and general stores factories since early 1965.
- (ii) The production of a number of old type of ammunition items was considerably less during 1965.
- (iii) Though production of a number of new items was commenced during 1965, the effect in value of production will not materialise till sometime in 1966.

(b) and (c). The value of production in the Ordnance and Clothing Factories during the year 1964-65 was Rs. 143.75 crores. The programme relating to the establishment of capacities for new armament items and increasing capacities of those already in production, where necessary, is being implemented.

**Afro-Asian Solidarity Conference in Kanpur**

**The Minister of External Affairs (Shri Swaran Singh):** (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) Apart from India, 82 countries are reported to have participated as members and 21 countries as observers.

(c) The declared objective of the Conference was the promotion of solidarity among Asian, African and Latin American countries.

(d) The Conference passed a number of resolutions declaring its faith in peaceful co-existence, non-alignment, democracy and socialism and reiterating its struggle against imperialism and colonialism. Resolutions were also passed supporting the Tashkent Conference, condemning British policy in Rhodesia and its policy concerning Viet Nam.
