(a) whether another seismology centre will be established at Bangalore to analyse the recorded data and develop techniques for discriminating the nuclear explosions from earthquakes; and

(b) if so, when it is likely to go into operation?

**The Prime Minister and Minister of Atomic Energy (Shrimati Indira Gandhi):** (a) and (b). The Nuclear Explosion Detection Centre in Gauribidnur, near Bangalore, went into operation in October 1965. It is proposed to put up a laboratory in Bangalore for detailed analysis of the data recorded. Meanwhile, as a temporary measure, a small unit has been set up at the Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore, and is already functioning.

The speeches were selected under the guidance of an Advisory Committee consisting of Prof. N. K. Siddhanta (Chairman) and Sarvashri S. A. Ayer, J. K. Bhonsle, and M. Sivaram. The selection carries a biographical introduction by Shri S. A.

Ayer. The first edition has been sold out and second edition of the publication was brought out recently.
