Delhi Calcutta Night Air Service

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION (DR. KARAN SINGH):
(a) and (b). With effect from the 11th November, 1968, Indian Airlines have introduced the Night Airmail Service which provides air connection between Delhi and Calcutta via Nagpur. There is no proposal to operate a direct night air service between Delhi and Calcutta.
