Export of Textiles to U.K.

1843. Shri Basumatari: Will the Minister of Commerce be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the export of cotton textiles from India to Britain in the current year is running at a higher level than in 1965; and
- (b) if so, what i_S the percentage of rise?

The Deputy Minister in the Ministry of Commerce (Shri Shafi Qureshi): (a) and (b). Yes, Sir. During the period January—July, 1966, for which figures are available, the total value of exports of cotton textiles to Britain was Rs. 871:62 Jakhs as against Rs. 723:79 lakhs during the corresponding period of 1965. This shows an increase of 20 p.c. over the exports during January—July, 1965.

Licences under U.S. Aid Programme

1844. Shri Umanath: Shri A. K. Gopalan: Shri Imbichibaya:

Will the Minister of Industry be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the attention of Government has been drawn to a statement of the Chairman of the Indiam Chemical Manufacturers Association in a recently held meeting of its Bombay Regional Committee in which he said that licences available under the U.S. Aid programme were not fully utilised because raw material prices in U.S.A. were higher by 30—40 percent than elsewhere;
- (b) if so, whether Government have verified the seatement and the conclusions arrived at; and
- (c) the efforts made by Government to find out alternative sources of supply in view of the high prices in U.S.A.?

The Minister of Industry (Shri D. Sanjivayya): (a) Yes, Sir.
