(c) The export of by products such as Beta Ionone and Synthetic Vitamin A has been stepped up which fetch more foreign exchange than the oil and also introduces import substitution in the country. The indigenous manufacturers are now using lemongrass oil instead of imported citronella oil, Lemongrass oil surplus to the requirements of indigenous manufacturers is being allowed for export.
