Strike at Hindustan Teleprinters. Madras

2750. Shri Nambiar: Will the Minister of Communications be pleased to

- (a) whether it is a fact that workers in the Hindustan Teleprinters at Madras were on strike from 3rd October to 9th November, 1966;
 - (b) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the workers of this factory are given the House Rent Allowance and City Compensatory Allowance as granted to the Central Government Employees; and
- (d) the steps taken to settle the dispute?

The Minister of State in the Departments of Parliamentary and Communications (Shri Jaganatha Rao): (a) Yes, the workers of the Teleprinters Madras, were on strike from the 3rd October to the 8th November, 1966;

- (b) Because the Management could not accept the demand of the workers for grant of house rent and city compensatory allowances at the rates for Central Government prescribed employees.
- (c) The workers of the Hindustan Teleprinters Ltd. not being Central Government employees, are not entitled to the payment of these allowances. The workers have, however, been allowed House Rent Allowance on the Madras Government based rates, with effect from the 1st March,
- (d) On an assurance given by the Minister of Parliamentary Affairs and Communications that he would per-
