- (c) The Secretary of the Board was invited to visit the universities in U.S. A. by the Danforth Foundation in 1967. In August, 1968, he attended the Tenth Congress of Commonwealth Universities held in Australia as a Member of the Indian delegation. The Secretary's visit to Hong-Kong was undertaken in a private capacity. In all the cases, his visits abroad were approved by the Board.
- (d) The visits have helped the Secretary and consequently the Board in understanding the present trend of changes taking place in higher education in other countries. It has also helped the Board in keeping a liaison with sister institutions/agencies for exchange of information.
 - (e) The Secretary of the Board who was formerly a University teacher is actively associated with the programmes of higher education in the country. He however, did not represent the country during his visit to the U.S.A. For visit to Australia he was nominated by the Board as a member of the Indian delegation.

Encounter with Rebel Nagas in Mongihan in Manipur

6822. SHRI BALRAJ MADAOK : Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether a large gang of Naga hostiles armed with light machine guns and other automatic weapons surprised a village volunteer force post at Monglhan in the Northern part of Ukhrul sub-division of Manipur on the 29th January, 1969 and took away eight rifles and ammunition from the post after a brief gun battle :

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI VIDYA CHARAN SHUKLA): (a) to (c). On the 29th January, 1969 about ten armed hostiles suspected to be Mizos/Kukis attacked the pest of the Village Volunteers at Monglhan in Sadar sub-division of Munipur and took away 8 rifles and some ammunition. The gang was chased and intercepted on 4th February, 1969. Six of the eight rifles were recovered along with some of the ammunition and two hostiles were captured. A case has been registered by the police. Three persons have been arrested and further, Investigation is in progress.

Clandestine Radio Transmitting Stations

6825. SHRI BALRAJ MADHOK: SHRI BENI SHANKAR SHARMA: SHRI RANJIT SINGH: SHRI D. C. SHARMA: SHRI HARDYAL DEVGUN:

Will the Minister of HOME AFF-AIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether he is aware that there are clandestine radio transmitting stations or instruments in India, which transmit secret information to foreign countries, especially to Pakistan from time to time;
- (b) if so, the steps taken to unearth the same and take suitable measures to deal with them; and
- (c) if no steps have been taken, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTARY OF HOME **AFFAIRS** (SHRI VIDYA CHARAN SHUKLA): (a) According to information shed by the State Governments of Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Gujarat, Haryana, Madhya Pradesh, Maharastra, Mysore, Nagaland, Orissa, Rajasthan and West Bengal and from the Union Territories no such clandestine transmitting station or equipment has come to notice. Information from the State Governments of J. & K., Kerala, Madras, Punjab, U. P. and the Union Territory of Himachal Pradesh is awaited.

(b) and (c). Do not arise.

Recommendations of Education Commission on Development of Science Subjects in Higher Secondary Schools

6824. SHRI K. LAKKAPPA: SHRI A. SREEDHARAN:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION AND YOUTH SERVICES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether all the recommendations of the Education Commission pertaining to the development of Science subjects in Higher Secondary Schools in the country have been implemented; and
 - (b) if so, the salient features thereof?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION AND YOUTH SERVICES (DR. V. K. R. V. RAO): (a) and (b). This is the concern of the State Governments to whom the recommendations of the Commission were forwarded for the consideration and implementation.

The Ministry of Education and Youth Services has helped the States in strengthening science laboratories of secondary schools and in-service of science teachers through an assistance of Rs. 6.78 crores during 1964-69. This scheme has been transferred to the State Sector in the 4th Plan. The National Council of Educational Research and Training has prepared model sylabi and some text-

books for existing higher secondary schools; and these have been forwarded to the States for such use as they think best.
