girl was kidnapped by Hanoi Consulate official in New Delhi recently; and

(b) if so, the reaction of Government in the matter?

THE MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI DINESH SINGH): (a) The Government of India has no information to this effect.

(b) Does not arise.

A. I. R. Station for Gorakhpur

279. DR. MAHADEVA PRASAD: Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that a Radio Station has been sanctioned for Gorakhpur; and

(b) if so, the progress made upto-date in its installation?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION, BROADCASTING AND COMMUNICA-TIONS (SHRI I. K. GUJRAL): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) Site for installation of the transmitter has been acquired and construction work is likely to commence soon. Steps to secure land for construction of studio building are under way.

Communal Writings in Newspapers

280. SHRI N. K. SANGHI: SHRI BIBHUTI MISHRA: SHRI B.K. DASCHOWDHURY:

Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Government propose to create a suitable machinery to scrutinise the Newspapers and periodicals containing communal writings; and (b) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION, BROADCASTING AND COMMUNICA-TIONS (SHRI I. K. GUJRAL): (a) and (b). Scrutiny of communal writings in the newspapers and periodicals in various languages is already being done by the Press Information Bureau, and the Chief Press Adviser's organisation.

Unemployment Problem Of Technicians And Post-Graduates

281. SHRI YAMUNA PRASAD MANDAL: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Planning Commission have considered the growing unemployment problem amongst the technicians and post-graduates in the country;

(b) if so, the schemes formulated for inclusion in the Fourth Five Year Plan in this regard;

(c) whether the implications of the 'technological dilemma' and the Japanese way' referred to in the speech of the Deputy Chairman, Planning Commission in November last, have been studied; and

(d) if so, Governments' reaction thereto?

THE PRIME MINISTER, MINISTER OF ATOMIC ENERGY AND MINISTER OF PLANNING (SHRIMATI INDIRA GANDHI): (a) Yea, Sir.

(b) The schemes to be included in the Fourth-Five Year Plan are under consideration.

(c) and (d). These are being studied. While there is scope in India for the adoption of an intermediate type of technology, a considerable amount of research has to go into its adaptation.
