## DEMAND FROM MADHYA PRADESH FOR RUSSIAN MARINO AND RAMBOULLET SHEEP

8941. SHRI JAGANNATH RAO JOSHI: Will the Minister of FOOD AND AGRI-CULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Madhya Pradesh Government have placed a demand for Russian Marino and Ramboullet sheep and if so, in what number:
- (b) when and in what number the supply will be made; and
- (c) if full demand cannot be met, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FOOD, AGRICULTURE, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COOPERATION (SHRI ANNASAHIB SHINDE): (a) to (c). While finalising the programme of import of exotic sheep for 1969-70 and 1970-71, for improving the quality of wool of local sheep through cross-breeding, the Government of Madhya Pradesh along with other State Governments was requested to indicate their requirements of exotic sheep, both Russian Merino and Ramboullet. In response to this, the Director of Animal Husbandry in his latest communication has indicated the State's requirements as 40 Merino sheep-10 Rams and 30 Ewes for 1970-71 and 25 Ramboullet sheep during the next financial year. The requirement of these sheep have been included in the programme of imports proposed for 1970-71 and 1971-72.

(d) With effect from 1-4-70 the maximum financial limit for individual minor irrigation schemes has been increased from Rs. 15 lakhs to Rs. 25 lakhs in plain areas and to Rs. 30 lakhs in hilly areas.
