THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI VIDYA CHARAN SHUKLA): (a) No.

(b) It is not desirable to withdraw the cases against Policemen. The cases are pending in the courts and the law must be allowed to take its course so that the discipline is maintained in a force charged with maintenance of law and order.

- (b) The awards are given to individuals for distinguished service in their fields of activity.
- (c) The number of awards conferred on 26 January, 1970 is as follows :-
