(b) and (c). Consideration of each licence application necessitates fairly detailed examination of Various aspects. In many cases applicants do not furnish complete information on important aspects of their schemes, such as phased manufacturing programme, arrangements made for meeting foreign exchange requirements and terms of foreign collaboration etc. and references have often to be made to them for clarification additional information. Efforts are being made to dispose of the applications as quickly as possible and to streamline procedures. Further, powers have also been delegated to administrative Ministries to dispose of certain types of cases, without reference to the Licensing Committee. Meetings of the Licensing Committee are held frequently, once in every fortnight. The reasons for the delay are periodically discussed with the representatives of the various Ministries and directions are given by the Chairman of the Committee emphasising on all concerned the need for special attention for expeditious disposal of applications. Considerable progress has been made in recent months in the disposal of pending applications.
