Reservation of Seate for Diploma / Degree Holders in Engineering for Commission in Defence Forces

4543. SHRI NIHAL SINGH: Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether any proposal is lying under Government's consideration to keep some seats reserved for Diploma and Degree Holders in Engineering for direct Commission and Short Service Commission in the Defence forces in view of the increasing unemployment of Engineers; and

(b) if so, the details of the Schemes

THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI JAGJIWAN RAM) : (a) and (b). Under the existing rules, candidates with engineering degrees are eligible for grant of Permanent and Short Service Commission in the Army and Air Force and direct entry Short Service Commission in the Navy. Engineering diploma holders can qualify for admission to the Indian Military Academy or Officers Training School in the Army. They are considered for Commission in a technical Corps if there is a shortage of with degree candidates qualifications. Diploma holders are not eligible for grant of Commission in the Navy and Air Force.

No proposal for reservation of vacancies for diploma holders in the Defence Services is under consideration.
