Import of Computers

4918. SHRI R. R. SINGH DEO: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government have allowed the import of Computers by several Companies;
- (b) whether conditions have been laid down that these firms will have to export machinery worth twice the cost of computer within two years; and
- (c) the foreign exchange likely to be earned therefrom and how the import of such computer would help our industry.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS. AND MINISTER OF STATE. DEPARTMENTS OF ELECTRONICS AND SCIENTIFIC AND INDUSTRIAL RESEARCH (SHRI K. C. PANT): (a) to (c). Government have received some proposals, for allowing import of computers, for the development of computer "software" primarily for export. These proposals are under consideration. Wherever such import of computers is permitted, the importer will have to guarantee a minimum export of "software" of sizeable value over a period of years in order to earn more than the foreign exchange expended on the computer import, No import of computers has been permitted so far for this purpose.
