Hostels for the Youth

- 216. SHRI AJIT JOGI: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:
- (a) the number of Youth Hostels set up, Statewise;
- (b) the facilities made available by the Government to these Hostels; and
- (c) the number of people benefited by these in each State?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (KUMARI UMA BHARTI): (a) The State-wise list of Youth Hostels is given in the statement attached.

- (b) Youth Hostels are established as a joint venture between the Department of Youth Affairs & Sports and the State Governments. While the Central Government bears the cost of construction, the State Governments provide fully developed land free of cost, with water and electricity connections, approach road to the site of the hostel and accommodation for the essential staff. They also bear the initial operational cost of the hostel. A sum of Rs. 1,60,000/- is provided by the Central Government for furniture/furnishing.
- (c) A large number of youth travelling on their educational excursions, youth exchange programmes, integration camps and various other youth activities are immensely benefited by these Hostels which provide accommodation at reasonable rate with basic amenities required.
