Regarding setting up of tourist circuit at Fatehgarh Sahib and providing Minimum Support Price for farmers of wheat and paddy.

DR. AMAR SINGH (FATEHGARH SAHIB): I thank you, Hon. Chairman Sir, for giving me the opportunity to speak on two important subjects of urgent public importance.

Sir, I am an elected MP of Shri Fatehgarh Sahib. This is the place where during Aurangzeb?s rule, governor Wazir Khan had walled alive two Sahibzadas of the Tenth Guru Shri Guru Gobind Singh.

I had requested the Central Government that Fatehgarh Sahib should be brought in the International Tourist Circuit and all facilities should be provided there so that all Sikh pilgrims and other devotees could have a ?darshan? of the site here.

Secondly, Sir, I wish to raise the issue of farmers. When the Farmers? Agitation ended, the Central Government had promised that in line with the MSP being provided on wheat and paddy, they will make arrangements for providing MSP for all the crops. However, nothing has been done in this regard.

In Punjab, the sugarcane farmers are being beaten on roads for demanding MSP.

Sir, farmers are providers of foodgrains in the country. We must fulfil promises made to the farmers. Their demands must be met.
