Re: Sanctioning of a Multimodal Logistics Park in Jalgaon

SHRI UNMESH BHAIYYASAHEB PATIL (JALGAON): The Government has launched the National Logistics Policy which aims to out logistics costs by half to be near global benchmarks by 2030 by reducing the cost of logistics from 14 to 18 per cent of GDP to global best practices of 8 per cent.
