Need to make redressal mechanisms for labourers in Himalayan region? laid

SHRI JAMYANG TSERING NAMGYAL (LADAKH): Labours in India are one of the vulnerable sections of the society. In India, they are facing many problems when they migrate to a new place. In this regard, it is requested that the Government develop redressal mechanisms particularly in Himalayas region where labours are highly needed to serve in road and construction, potters, trekking, and other purposes. There have been various issues tabled at public domains in payment, high altitude, extreme cold, accommodations, food and drinking water and other basic daily requirements. In context to UT Ladakh, there is abundance of labour from countryside which is brought through various agents. It is reported that they have been exploited in terms of monthly wages. Even in harsh winter, labourers are kept in tents, lagging of warm clothes and heating facilities. I request the Government to recruit and give care to them through Department of Labour Welfare particularly in UT Ladakh of Nubra region, Changthang belt, Drass belt, and Zanskar ranges.
