Report

Action Taken by the Ministry of Education (Department of Higher Education) on the Observations / Recommendations made by the Committee in their 122nd Report (Seventeenth Lok Sabha) regarding the delay in laying of the Annual Reports and Audited Accounts of the Indian Institute of Information Technology, Dharwad.

This Report of the Committee deals with the action-taken by the Ministry of Education (Department of Higher Education) on the Recommendations/Observations made by the Committee on Papers Laid on the Table (2022-2023) in their 122nd Report (17th Lok Sabha) which dealt with the matter of the delay in laying the Annual Reports and Audited Accounts of the Indian Institute of Information Technology, Dharwad and which was presented to the Lok Sabha on 03rd April, 2023.

- 2. The Committee had made three Observations/Recommendations in their 122nd Report (17th Lok Sabha). The action-taken replies to all the three Observations/Recommendations have been received from the Government vide OM –52-2/2022-TS.I dated 6 June, 2023.
- 3. The Observations/Recommendations made by the Committee, the Action Taken Replies received from the Ministry and comments of the Committee thereon are as under-

Recommendation No. 17

4. The Committee had recommended as under:-

"The Committee note that the Ministry of Education (Department of Higher Education) and the Indian Institute of Information Technology, Dharwad have not adhered to the time line stipulated in section 37(3) of the Indian Institute of Information Technology (Public-Private Partnership) Act, 2017 and as per the GFR 237(iii) which states that the Annual Reports along with Audited Statement of Accounts of the IIITs shall be prepared and released before the expiry of the nine months from the closure of the Financial Year. The mandatory requirement of laying these two documents has not been compiled for the years 2015-16 to 2020-21. The documents were laid with an average delay of more than 07 months to 22 months for the years 2015-16 to 2020-21 (6 years).

The Ministry/IIIT Dharwad also did not adhere to section 37(2) of IIIT(PPP) Act, 2017 according to which the Annual Report as approved by the Board shall be published and placed on the website of the Institute. The Committee would like to be apprised about the action taken by the Ministry in this regard."

5. The Ministry in its action taken replies has stated as under:-

"The Annual Reports & Audited Accounts in respect of IIIT Dharwad have been laid on in both the Houses of the Parliament as per the details given below:

Steps taken by the Ministry:

- (i) The Institute has published and placed all the above mentioned Annual Reports & Audited Accounts on its website.
- (ii) Apart from time to time reminders to the Institute, this Ministry vide O.M. No. 52-2/2022-TS.I dated 25.07.2022 (<u>Annexure 1</u>.) has also requested Ministry of Finance to take up the matter with C&AG for adhering to the timelines for finalization of Audited Accounts especially for conduct of audit and dispatch of Separate Audit Report (SAR).
- (iii) A PORTAL has been prepared by the Ministry which reminds the Institutes to complete the data entry on timely basis and daily reminders starts 7 days prior to deadline. Also, a day before the last day, a reminder e- mail is sent."
- 6. The Committee appreciate the various steps taken by the Ministry to ensure timely laying of the requisite documents of the Institute. The Committee hope that with these measures, the Annual Report and Audited Accounts of the Institute will be laid on the Table of the House within the stipulated time in future.

Recommendation Serial No. 18

7. The Committee had recommended as under:-

"While examining the reasons for delays in laying the documents of the IIIT, Dharwad, the Committee note that the delays were at each stage of setting up of the Institute, delay in appointment of Directors, compilation of accounts; submission of accounts to

the audit authority, time taken up by the audit authorities for finalization of the accounts of the Institute and also time taken up by the Ministry to lay the documents on the Table of the House. The Committee also understands the actual problems faced by them in the process of finalization of documents. However, the committee recommends that the time schedule prepared by the Ministry may be scrupulously followed so that the documents are laid on the Table of the House timely.

8. The Ministry in its action taken replies has stated as under:-

"The suggestions of the Committee have been noted for compliance. In future, utmost care will be taken to adhere to timelines for laying of Annual Report & Audited Accounts"

9. The Committee are happy to note that the suggestions of the Committee have been noted by the Ministry and it has been assured that in future, utmost care would be taken to adhere to timelines for laying of the requisite documents of the IIIT, Dharwad.

Recommendation Serial No. 19

10. The Committee had recommended as under:-

"The Committee impress upon the Ministry that if due to unavoidable reasons, the Annual Reports and Audited Accounts of the IIIT, Dharwad, could not be laid on the Table of the House with in the stipulated time, a statement explaining the reasons as to why the requisite documents could not be laid within the prescribed time period must be laid on the Table of the House within 30 days or as soon as the House convenes, whichever is later."

11. The Ministry in its action taken replies has stated as under:-

"The Ministry will ensure to adhere to the timelines for laying of Annual Report & Audited Accounts."

12. The Committee are happy to note that the Ministry has accepted the recommendation made by the Committee. However, the Committee desire that in case of unavoidable reasons, when the Annual Reports and Audited Accounts of the Institute cannot be laid on the Table of the House within the stipulated time, a statement explaining the reasons as to why the requisite documents cannot be laid within the prescribed time period should be laid on the Table of the House within 30 days after the expiry of the stipulated time or as soon as the House convenes whichever is later.


