

Regarding development of infrastructure of Kendriya Vidyalaya and Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya in Bhadrak Parliamentary Constituency

SHRIMATI MANJULATA MANDAL (BHADRAK): The educational infrastructure in three schools that is Kendriya Vidyalaya (KV) at Bhadrak, Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya (JNV) at Bagudi, Soro and another Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya at Chandimal, Basudevpur is very poor and in fact in dilapidated condition, therefore, impairing the educational status of young students. It is shocking that teaching and non-teaching staffs are inadequate to impart education at the desirable level. Hence, there is an urgent need to fill up the vacant posts of teaching and non-teaching staff equipping the above three schools with modern educational equipments and technology to ensure the intellectual development of students studying there at par with the national level so that they can compete with others. To fulfil such requirements, these schools need adequate funds for the above stated purpose. Under the said circumstances I request the Hon'ble Union Minister for Education to allocate adequate fund on priority basis for improving the physical infrastructure of above mentioned schools for renovation and construction of buildings, provision of adequate teaching and non-teaching staff, latest equipments and modern tools of education etc.
