

Regarding opening of a Kendriya Vidyalaya in Chalakudy Constituency

SHRI BENNY BEHANAN (CHALAKUDY): Thank you, hon. Chairperson Sir, for giving me this opportunity. My submission is regarding opening of a Kendriya Vidyalaya in my constituency. I have made this request several times before the Government through my verbal submissions and letters.

Sir, Kendriya Vidyalayas are opened primarily to cater to the educational needs of the wards of transferable Central Government employees, including those from Defence and Paramilitary Forces, Central Autonomous Bodies, Central Public Sector Undertakings, and Central Institutes of Higher Learning, by providing a common programme of education throughout the country.

There are many Kendriya Vidyalayas in other constituencies of Kerala but in my constituency, Chalakudy, there is not even one. In my constituency, many employees are working in the railway sector, coastguards, and in the Air Force. We also have the CISF staff working in the Cochin International Airport and in other Central Government institutions. Hence, a Kendriya Vidyalaya is most needed in our constituency for the education of their children.

Therefore, I request the Central Government to kindly initiate a proposal to start a Kendriya Vidyalaya in my constituency, Chalakudy. Further, I would like to inform the Government that the required land is also available there.
