NEW INDUSTRIES IN JHARKHAND

- (a) whether the Government is planning to start and operate new industries in the rural areas in the country specially in Jharkhand and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Union Government is extending assistance for establishment of new industries in Jharkhand; and
- (c) if so, the details of assistance provided by the Union Government during the last three years and the current year, company-wise and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (c): Setting up of industry is primarily the domain of State Governments. Government of India, however, provides support for promotion of industrial activities across the country. Government of India, through Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT) and other Central Ministries/Departments, provide an enabling eco-system for the overall industrial development of the country through appropriate policy interventions.

In addition to ongoing schemes of various Departments and Ministries, Government has taken various other steps for promotion and facilitating of setting up of industries across States/UTs such as Make in India, Start Up India, PM Gati Shakti, National Infrastructure Pipeline (NIP), National Industrial Corridor Programme, Production Linked Incentive Scheme (PLI), promoting Ease of Doing Business (EoDB) and reducing compliance burden, National Single Window System (NSWS), India Industrial Land Bank (IILB), reforms in Foreign Direct Investment (FDI), Project Monitoring Group (PMG), North East Industrial Development Scheme (NEIDS), 2017 for North East States of India, New Central Sector Scheme for Industrial Development of Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir etc which facilitate setting up of major infrastructure projects across the country. Also, an institutional mechanism to fast track investments has been put in place in the form of Project Development Cells (PDCs) in all concerned Ministries/Departments of Government of India.
