- (b) the number of weavers in the country particularly in the State of Tamil Nadu, especially in the Karur constituency, that have been provided training in technical areas under the skill upgradation training programme;
- (c) the number of weavers in the country especially in Tamil Nadu (Karur constituency) that have been provided upgraded looms/accessories, lighting units and individual work sheds under the scheme;
- (d) the State-wise data on the number of loans sanctioned under Concessional Credit/Weaver MUDRA scheme since 2019, especially for the State of Tamil Nadu and Karur Parliamentary Constituency; and
- (e) the State-wise details of yarn provided to handloom weavers/societies under the Raw Material Supply Scheme, especially for the State of Tamil Nadu and Karur Parliamentary Constituency?

(a): Ministry of Textiles is implementing the following schemes to promote the handloom sector and welfare of handloom workers across the country including State of Tamil Nadu:

1. National Handloom Development Programme(NHDP)
2. Raw Material Supply Scheme(RMSS)

Under the above schemes, need based financial assistance is provided to the eligible handloom agencies/workers on receipt of complete proposals from States/UTs Governments for various interventions like raw materials, procurement of upgraded looms & accessories, solar lighting units, construction of work sheds, product & design development, technical & common infrastructure, marketing of handloom products in domestic/overseas markets, concessional loans under weaver's MUDRA scheme and social security etc.

Since 2015-16 to 2023-24 (till 31.10.2023), financial assistance has been provided to 687 handloom clusters across the country including 76 clusters in the State of Tamil Nadu.

(b) & (c): Details of the number of handloom workers provided skill upgradation training, upgraded looms/accessories, lighting units and individual work sheds in the country including State of Tamil Nadu and Karur district from 2015-16 to 2023-24 (till 31.10.2023), are as under:

(d) & (e): State-wise number of loans sanctioned under Concessional Credit/Weaver MUDRA scheme from 2019-20 to 2023-24 (till 31.10.2023) and quantity of yarn supplied to handloom weavers/societies under Raw Material Supply Scheme from 2020-21 to 2023-24(till 31.10.2023) in the country including State of Tamil Nadu is given at Annexure-A. Further, 710 loans were sanctioned and 14.95 lakh kg of yarn was supplied in Karur district during the above mentioned period.
