Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of black spot areas identified by the Government/NHAI on the National Highways (NHs) across the country as on date;**
- (b) whether the Government is aware that most of the accidents occur on these black spot areas of NHs and if so, the details thereof;**
- (c) the number of accidents occurred on these areas of NHs during the last five years;**
- (d) the total number of deaths caused due to these accidents in the country during the said period, State/UT-wise;**
- (e) whether the Government has taken any measures to repair these black spots and if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise;**
- (f) the details of the funds sanctioned, released and spent by the NHAI for the said purpose under these measures, State/UT-wise; and**
- (g) whether any Road Safety Authority has been set up by the Government to identify the road accidents on the NHs and if so, the current status thereof?**

**ANSWER
THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT & HIGHWAYS

(a) to (e) Based on the scrutiny of the road accident data provided by the respective States/UTs, Ministry has identified 5803 black spots

on the entire NH network in the country. State/UT-wise details of the accidents/fatalities at these black spots based on the accident data for the calendar years 2018 to 2020 received from the concerned States/UTs and status of rectification of these black spots is annexed.

(f) NHAI has spent an amount of Rs 15,702.80 Crore for repair and maintenance including measures taken for improvement of above said black spots on NHs entrusted to NHAI during the last five financial years 2018-19 to 2022-23.
