**STATEMENT IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (e) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO.\*202 ANSWERED ON 18.12.2023 REGARDING DEVELOPMENT OF TOURIST DESTINATIONS BY SHRI S. MUNISWAMY**

**(a) & (b):** Development and promotion of tourist destinations is primarily undertaken by the respective State Governments/UT Administrations. However, the Ministry of Tourism compliments these efforts by providing financial assistance under its schemes of 'Swadesh Darshan' and 'Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD)' to State Governments/Union Territory (UT) Administrations. In addition, the Ministry of Tourism also provides financial support to Central Agencies under its scheme 'Assistance to Central Agencies'. The objective to extend the financial assistance under the above mentioned schemes is to augment tourism infrastructure at the identified destinations/sites. The details of the projects sanctioned under the above mentioned schemes are at Annexure-I. The Ministry of Tourism has revamped its Swadesh Darshan scheme as Swadesh Darshan scheme 2.0 (SD2.0) in order to develop sustainable and responsible tourist destinations following tourist & destination centric approach. List of destinations notified for development under SD2.0 is at Annexure-II.
