This year in 2023-24, four odias, including two from Western odisha got padma award, Shri Binod pasayat from Sambalpur and Guru Bhagabat pradhan fron Bargarh, my constituency.

Sir Sambalpuri language is spoken by more than two crores of people in odisha. Sambalpuri music, dance, drama etc are very popular. It has its own grammar, words and literature. Exclusive musical instruments like Dhol, Mandal, Nishan, Tasha are used in Dance like Dal khai, Raserkeli etc. Now the time has come to include Sambalpuri language in the 8th schedule of the constitution.
