It is so inconvenient. During the Corona time, some trains were started with special fare. Now Covid situation no longer exists, but those trains continue to charge hiked fare. Why the pre Covid fares are not reintroduced? Bardhhaman-Malda Town Passenger train was introduced when Mamata Bandyopadhyay was the Railway minister. That train has been discontinued altogether, it is so surprising. Moreover there are some trains which stops while going up but does not stop in the down route and vice versa. I have raised these issues time and again with hon. Minister, with the GM, with DRM, but nothing happened. For last five years I have been making hue and cry and have become tired now. Kindly look into it.
