On a point of order whether the term 'Non-sense' used by a Member, during discussion on Andhra Bill, the Speaker ruled that firstly it was said that some speeches were full of sense and then that other speeches were full of non-sense. 'Non-sense' had not been used otherwise than in contradistinction to 'sense'. Therefore it was not unparliamentary in that context. 1130.

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A —— arises in respect to a matter which is current in the House and not over things which are either over or yet to be taken up. 107-08, 109-14.

A —— is an extraordinary process which, when raised has the effect of suspension of proceeding before the House. As regards scope of rule 291 any Member can raise any point of order at any time on any matter then under discussion but not after that business is over. 447-48.
