UNSTARRED QUESTION AND ANSWER.*

244. Lala Girdharilal Agarwala: (a) Is it a fact that motor car owners who purchase a car for Rs. 4,000 have to pay taxes on it in the first year amounting to Rs. 1,297 and thereafter nearly 10 per cont. of the initial cost every year subsequently as printed in the *Pioneer* of Allababad, dated 8th March, 1933, at page 14?

(b) Are the Government aware that the United Provinces Government proposes to impose a further tax of Rs. 180 yearly on each motor car?

(c) If the reply be in the affirmative, do the Government propose to do

anything in the matter?
