Will the Minister of Women and Child Development be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of aggrieved women served by One Stop Centres (OSCs) in Andhra Pradesh over the last year, district-wise;
- (b) the funds allocated and utilized by OSCs in the State during the said period, district-wise:
- (c) whether the Government plans to extend the duration of shelter provided to aggrieved women under OSCs, if so, the measures proposed for the implementation; and
- (d) whether the Government plans to introduce skill development programs for women beneficiaries of OSCs in Andhra Pradesh to enhance their economic independence, if not, the reasons therefor?
