- b) whether the reports of excavation have been presented to ASI;

- d) if so, the details of the reports and also provide copies thereof;
- e) whether the ASI has subjected the findings of Keeladi excavation to carbon dating;
- f) If so, the details thereof; and
- g) If not, the reasons therefor?

- (a) The Archaeological Survey of India carried out archaeological excavations at Keeladi, Sivaganga district, Tamil Nadu for the field season 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17.
- (b) The report on the excavations at Keeladi has been submitted for the field season 2014-15 and 2015-16.
- (c) & (d) The vetted report for the field season 2014-15 and 2015-16 is awaited.
- (e) & (f) Yes Sir, several samples from the Keeladi excavation were subjected to carbon dating and the range of dates is from 280 BCE to 680 CE.
