UNEMPLOYED PEOPLE OF TRIBAL COMMUNITY

992. Dr. MANNA LAL RAWAT :

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any data regarding educated unemployed people belonging to tribal community;**
- (b) if so, the number of unemployed persons belonging to tribal communities of Rajasthan State from the year 2019 to 2023;**
- (c) the details of arrangements made by the Government to provide employment to the said people; and**
- (d) the number of persons benefitted under various skill development schemes implemented by the Government along with the number of persons belonging to Scheduled Tribes out of them?**

ANSWER

(a) to (d): As per the Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) Reports, the estimated Unemployment Rate (UR) on usual status for tribal community was 3.4 % in 2019-20, 2.7 % in 2020-21, 2.4 % in 2021-22 and 1.8 % in 2022-23. PLFS Report provides estimates for different social groups on all India level.

The Employment generation coupled with improving employability is the priority of the Government. Accordingly, the Government of India has taken various steps for generating employment in the country including the state of Rajasthan.

The various Ministries/Departments of Government of India like Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises, Ministry of Rural Development, Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs, Ministry of Finance, Ministry of Textile, Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology etc. are implementing different employment generation schemes/programmes like Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme(MGNREGS), Pt. Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY), Rural Self-Employment and Training Institutes (RSETIs), Deen Dayal Antodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM), Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana (PMMY), etc. including increase in capital expenditure to boost employment creation in the country including the state of Rajasthan. The details of various employment generation schemes/programmes being implemented by the Government of India may be seen at https://dge.gov.inschemes_programmes.

Further, Government is implementing various skill development schemes namely Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Jan Sikhshan Sansthan (JSS), National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) and Craftsman Training Scheme (CTS) through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) in the country including the state of Rajasthan and the no. of persons benefitted under the said schemes is 11,07,220 including the persons belonging to Schedule Tribes during the year 2019-20 to 2022-23 in Rajasthan.
