#### PROTECTION AND PROMOTION OF THE CULTURE OF TRIBAL COMMUNITY

†1029. SHRI RAJKUMAR ROAT:

Will the Minister of CULTUREbe pleased to state:

- (a) the efforts made by the Government to protect and promote the culture of tribal community in the country and the amount spent on such measures during the last five years, State-wise/year-wise and scheme-wise details thereof;
- (b) whether the population of Bhil tribal community is more in the States of Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra and Gujarat as compared to other States and the efforts made by the Central Government to protect the culture of Bhil community and the amount of budget spent in this regard and the details thereof; and
- (c) whether the Government proposes to implement any special scheme for the protection and promotion of culture of Bhil community residing in the above mentioned four States and the details thereof?

#### ANSWER

## MINISTER OF CULTURE AND TOURISM (SHRI GAJENDRA SINGH SHEKHAWAT)

(a) & (b) Government of India has taken various steps to conserve and protect the tribal culture, traditions and customs. Ministry of Tribal Affairs is implementing the schemes of "Support to Tribal Research Institutes and Tribal Research, Information, Education, Communication and Events" under which various activities are undertaken to conserve and promote tribal culture, archives, artefacts, customs and traditions of the tribal communities.

To promote the tribal culture, various festivals like Hornbill Festival, Octave, Tribal Dance Festival, Adi Bimb, Adi Sapta Pallav, Adi Lok Rang, Adiwasi Mahotsav etc. are organized through Zonal Cultural Centres (ZCCs) of Ministry of Culture to showcase unique forms of folk dances, songs, cuisine, exhibitions and demonstration of traditional skill in painting, art & craft, medicinal practices etc.

Under the Scheme of "Tribal Research, Information, Education, Communication and Events (TRI-ECE)", reputed research Institutes/ Organizations/ Universities have undertaken various research studies/ publication of books/ documentation including audio visual documentaries etc.

The population of Bhil tribal community in the States of Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra and Gujarat as per Census 2011 are 42,05,657 in Rajasthan, 59,96,165 in Madhya Pradesh, 25,88,659 in Maharashtra and 42,70,609 in Gujarat.

To protect and promote the culture of tribal community including Bhil community, tribal artists are engaged by ZCCs to showcase their talent during tribal dance festivals, painting camps, craft fairs for which they are paid honorarium, TA/DA, local transportation, boarding & lodging etc. to enable them to earn their livelihood.

The details of funds released to protect and promote the tribal culture including Bhil Community under the Schemes of 'Support to Tribal Research Institutes (TRIs) and Tribal Research, Information, Education, Communication & Events (TRI-ECE)' during the last 5 years are given at **Annexure-I**.

(c) No such proposal is under consideration of Ministry of Tribal Affairs. However, some projects under the scheme 'Support to TRIs' for Bhil community in the States of Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra were undertaken. The details of such proposals are at **Annexure-II**.
