1310 Shri Rajesh Ranjan:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENTbe pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Union Government has launched the National Social Assistance Programme(NSAP) to provide social security to the destitute, population living Below the Poverty Line (BPL)and vulnerable groups and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the total number of beneficiaries of NSAP schemes in the State of Bihar, District-wise andthe quantum of funds released during the last three years, scheme-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has undertaken any exercise to find out due number of personswho are eligible to get the benefits of NSAP schemes in Bihar, are not getting the benefits of NSAP schemes; and
- (d) the steps proposed to be taken to ensure that all eligible persons should get benefits of NSAP schemes in Bihar?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI KAMLESH PASWAN)

(a) Yes. National Social Assistance Programme (NSAP), launched on 15th August, 1995, is implemented across the country as a social security programme, primarily meant for vulnerable sections of the society such as old aged, widows, and disabled persons belonging to Below Poverty Line (BPL). The Programme has undergone many changes over the years in terms of the composition, eligibility criterion and funding pattern. Details of schemes covered under NSAP along with eligibility criteria are given in Annexure-I. (b) District-wise details of total number of beneficiaries under NSAP schemes in the State of Bihar is given in Annexure-II. Schemewise details of funds released for State of Bihar under NSAP during last three years is given below:

(c) & (d) : As per the guidelines of NSAP, it is the responsibility of the States to adhere to a policy for prioritizing the beneficiaries on the basis of socio-economic and health conditions. The outlay along with state-wise cap of beneficiaries for 2021-26 in respect of all States/ UTs including Bihar have been approved by the Union Cabinet. However, if there are more deserving beneficiaries, the States/ UTs have the option to give them pension from their own resources.
