## **Accidents in Coal Mines**

#### 1457. Dr. K Sudhakar:

Will the Minister of Coal be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government is planning to stop the usage of coal mining in the country, and if so, details thereof;

(b) whether the Government has data regarding the total number of laborers employed in coal and other mining sectors in India, if so, the details thereof, State and sector-wise;

(c) whether the Government has data regarding the total number of active mines both under Central and State Governments, in Karnataka and if so, the details thereof;

(d) whether the Government has observed frequent accidents in mining trenches of Karnataka and if so, the details thereof; and

(e) the details of compensation paid to mine workers in the case of landslides /accidents in mines of Karnataka. during the FY 2023-24, and 2024-25?

# ANSWER MINISTER OF COAL AND MINES (SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

(a): No Sir. The country has envisaged growing demand of coal in coming years primarily to meet power demand and energy security of the country. It has been projected that total coal demand by 2029-30 will be 1570.26 MT. Government has planned to increase production of coal to meet the demand.

(b): Details of manpower employed by Coal India Limited, as on 01.07.2024, is at Annexure-I. Total number of employees in Singareni Collieries Company Limited (SCCL) (in State of Telangana), as on 30.06.2024, is 41,685. The details of manpower employed by NLC India Limited (NLCIL), as on 01.07.2024, is as under:

(c): No coal mine is located in the State of Karnataka. Further, DGMS has informed that there are 14 active mines in Karnataka, out of which 12 mines are owned by the State Government of Karnataka and 2 mines are owned by the Central Government.

(e): State Government of Karnataka has informed that no accidents of landslides were reported. However, in one case i.e. P. Balasubbasetty (ML No. 2502) situated at Sandur Taluk, Ballari District, the dump was slided into the adjacent forest area for which necessary action has been initiated against the lessee. In this regard, Department of Mines Safety has also taken action. No casualties was reported in the said case. Since, no incidents of landslides were reported, payment of compensation does not arise.
