(a) Government of India, in partnership with States, is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) to make provision of potable tap water supply to every rural household in the country. To enable individuals, institutions, corporates, philanthropists, etc., who have a desire to ‘give back to the society’ and be a part of this movement, a ‘Rashtriya Jal Jeevan Kosh (RJJK)’ was set up to receive contributions/ donations to achieve the goal of Jal Jeevan Mission. A dedicated website <https://jaljeevankosh.gov.in> has been developed to facilitate donations/ contributions, which can be made directly through RJJK website and also through JJM mobile app. As on 29.07.2024, a sum of Rs. 1,83,143.77/- has been received as contribution in the account of RJJK.
