- (a) the total number of trains operational from Budaun Railway Station to New Delhi and the details thereof;**
- (b) whether the Government is aware that thousands of passengers use to board the train from other stations for further travelling from Budaun to New Delhi;**
- (c) whether the Government proposes to operate any Mail/Express/Passenger Trains between New Delhi and Budaun in view of the public interest; and**
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?**

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF STARRED QUESTION NO. 237 BY SHRI ADITYA YADAV TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 07.08.2024 REGARDING OPERATION OF TRAINS FROM BUDAUN RAILWAY STATION

(a) to (d) Budaun station is presently being served by 03 pairs of Mail/Express and 04 pairs of passenger train services connecting it *inter alia* to Mumbai, Surat, Vadodara, Agra, Bareilly, etc. For travelling to Delhi, passengers of Budaun may avail changeover at Bareilly which is well connected to Delhi by 31 pairs of Mail/Express trains including the services of 2 pairs of Rajdhani Express, 2 pairs of AC Express, 2 pairs of Garib Rath Express, 1 pair of Mahamana Express and 1 pair of Passenger train. Besides, introduction of new trains is an on-going process on Indian Railways subject to traffic justification, operational feasibility, resource availability, competing demands etc.
