- (a) Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) takes up conservation and maintenance & work of protected monuments and sites including provision of facilities like
- (b) drinking water, toilet blocks, pathways and landscaping etc. throughout the country, including 163 in the state of Rajasthan. Conservation and maintenance of monuments and archaeological sites is a continuous process and is taken up as per the need of monuments and availability of resources.
