SCHEMES FOR MSMEs IN 2024

2873. SHRI K E PRAKASH:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has introduced any new schemes in 2024 to support the growth and development of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs);
- (b) if so, the details of these schemes and types of support provided; and
- (c) the number of MSMEs benefited from these schemes, State-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SUSHRI SHOBHA KARANDLAJE)

- (a): The Government introduced the PM Vishwakarma Scheme in 2023-24. The Scheme was launched by the Hon'ble Prime Minister on 17.09.2023.
- (b): The Scheme aims to provide end-to-end support to artisans and craftspeople of 18 trades who work with their hands and tools. The Scheme components include recognition through PM Vishwakarma Certificate and ID Card, Skill Upgradation, Toolkit Incentive, Credit Support, Incentive for Digital Transactions and Marketing Support. The Scheme has been rolled out across the country and its benefits have been initiated.
- (c): The details of State/UT-wise total number of applications received under the Scheme are at **Annexure**.
