DATA OF FUNCTIONAL MSMEs IN TAMIL NADU

2879. SHRI SACHITHANANTHAM R:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Ministry is maintaining any data about the total number of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) presently functioning in Tamil Nadu as on date, district-wise;
- (b) the total number of such Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) in the said State which have been provided financial/technical assistance by the Ministry as on date; and
- (c) the total number of new MSMEs started/set up and functioning in the said State during the last three years, district-wise?

ANSWER

(a) and (c): Udyam Registration Portal was launched on 01.07.2020 with the new revised criteria for classification of MSMEs. As on 05.08.2024, the total number of MSMEs registered on Udyam Registration Portal and Udyam Assist Platform in the state of Tamil Nadu was 39,45,867 and the district-wise details are given in Annexure-I.

As on 05.08.2024, the total number of MSMEs incorporated in the state of Tamil Nadu on the Udyam Registration Portal during 01.04.2021 to 31.03.2024 was 9,74,586 and the district-wise details are given in Annexure-II.

(b): Udyam Registration helps MSMEs in availing the benefits of schemes of Ministry of MSME such as Credit Guarantee Scheme, Public Procurement Policy, additional edge in Government Tenders and protection against delayed payments etc.

To facilitate access to credit to MSMEs including Tamil Nadu, the Government has taken a number of initiatives vide programmes & schemes and announcements to support the MSMEs, which inter alia include (i) Collateral free loan up to a limit of Rs. 500 lakh (w.e.f. 01.04.23) to MSEs with guarantee coverage up to 85 % for various categories of loan through Credit Guarantee Fund Trust for Micro and Small Enterprises (CGTMSE) under Credit Guarantee Scheme; (ii) inclusion of retail and wholesale traders as MSMEs for Priority Sector Lending.

To further augment the credit facilities, Government has taken a number of initiatives as follows:

- i. Rs. 50,000 crore equity infusion through Self Reliant India Fund. This scheme has a provision for corpus of Rs.10,000 crore from Government of India.
- ii. Under PMEGP, maximum project cost admissible has been enhanced from Rs. 25 Lakhs to Rs. 50 Lakhs for Manufacturing sector and from Rs. 10 Lakhs to Rs. 20 Lakhs for Service sector.
- iii. New revised criteria for classification of MSMEs.
- iv. Non-tax benefits extended for 3 years in case of an upward change in status of MSMEs.
- v. Under Vivad se Vishwas – I, relief by way of refund of 95% of the deducted performance security, bid security and liquidated damages was provided to MSMEs. Relief was also provided to MSMEs debarred for default in execution of contracts.
- vi. Launch of Udyam Assist Platform (UAP) to bring the Informal Micro Enterprises (IMEs) under the formal ambit for availing the benefit under Priority Sector Lending (PSL).
- vii. Launch of ‘PM Vishwakarma’ Scheme on 17.09.2023 to provide end to end holistic benefits to the traditional artisans and craftspeople engaged in 18 trades, including access to subsidized credit.

Under the Prime Minister’s Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) during 2019-20 to 2023-24, 29,287 Micro enterprises have been assisted with Margin Money subsidy of Rs.80,496 lakh providing employment to an estimated 2.34 lakh persons in Tamil Nadu.

Under CGTMSE during 2019-20 to 2023-24, 3.71 lakh guarantees were approved involving an amount of Rs.34005.43crore in Tamil Nadu.

Also, the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) has established Technology Centres (TCs) which provide technological support to industries through design & manufacture of tools, precision components, moulds, dies etc. in sectors such as general engineering, forging & foundry, electronics, electrical, fragrance & flavour, glass, footwear and sports goods. The Ministry also implements various schemes and programmes aimed at providing investment for adoption of latest technologies in MSME sector.

Further, National Small Industries Corporation offers support services to small enterprises through its Technical Services Centres and Extension Centres. These technical support services include, advise on application of new techniques, material testing facilities through accredited laboratories, product design including CAD, common facility support in machining, EDM, CNC, etc., energy and environment services at selected centres and classroom and practical training for skill upgradation.
