Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of foreign tourists visited the country during the last three years, year-wise State and district-wise including the States of Himachal Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat and Rajasthan;**
- (b) whether the Government is targeting 100 million foreign tourist in the long run and the number of tourists expected to visit the country in the next five years;**
- (c) whether the Government has prepared any roadmap to boost the tourism industry in the country including state with Himachal Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat and Rajasthan and if so, the details thereof; and**
- (d) the aims and objectives of the Swadesh Darshan Scheme and the State-wise details of projects executed under the Scheme?**

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM (SHRI GAJENDRA SINGH SHEKHAWAT)

(a): The State-wise foreign tourist visits during the last three years including the States of Himachal Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat and Rajasthan is given in the Annexure-I.

(b): Domestic tourism reached pre-pandemic levels in 2023. Additionally, based on data from the Bureau of Immigration (BOI), Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs) are expected to reach pre-pandemic levels by 2024.

No projection has been made regarding the expected number of tourists in the next five years.

(c): Ministry of Tourism has taken several steps/initiatives over the years to give boost to the tourism sector in the country including the states of Himachal Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat and Rajasthan, details of which are:

- (i) Launched Dekho Apna Desh initiative with the objective of creating awareness among the citizens about the rich heritage and culture of the country and encourage citizens to travel within the country.**
- (ii) Conducting Programmes under the 'Capacity Building for Service Providers' (CBSP) Scheme to train and upgrade manpower to provide better service standards.**
- (iii) Launched Incredible India Tourist Facilitator Certification Programme, a digital initiative that aims at creating an online learning platform with the objective of creating a pool of well trained professional tourist facilitators across the country to support tourists.**
- (iv) 24x7 toll free Multi-Lingual Tourist Helpline.**
- (v) E-Visa is presently available under seven sub-categories i.e. e-Tourist Visa, e- Business Visa, e-Medical Visa, e-Medical Attendant Visa, e-Conference Visa, e- Ayush Visa and e-Ayush Attendant Visa. e-Tourist visa is available under 3 options – (i) 05 years with multiple entry; (ii) 1 year with multiple entry and (iii) one month with double entry.**
- (vi) Under RCS UDAN Tourism, Ministry of Tourism has collaborated with Ministry of Civil Aviation and has got 53 tourism routes operational for better connectivity of important tourist places including Iconic sites.**

(d): The Ministry of Tourism launched its Swadesh Darshan scheme in the year 2014-15 under which financial assistance is provided to the State/UT Administrations/Central Agencies etc. for development of Tourism Infrastructure in the country. The financial assistance is provided in consultation with States/UT Administrations etc. Since its inception in 2014-15 till 2018-19, a total number of 76 projects under 14 thematic circuits, have been sanctioned in the country for a revised sanction amount of Rs.5294.11 crore and Rs.4865.8 crore has been released.

The Ministry has revamped its Swadesh Darshan scheme as Swadesh Darshan 2.0 (SD2.0) with the objective to develop sustainable and responsible tourism destinations, following a tourist & destination centric approach.

The details of state-wise projects sanctioned under Swadesh Darshan scheme and projects identified under SD2.0 is at Annexure-II.
