STATUS OF DIGITAL LITERACY IN INDIA

404. KM. SUDHA R:

Will the Minister of ELECTRONICS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware of the Digital Literacy rates for rural and urban areas;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (c) whether the Government is aware of the Digital Literacy rates for Tamil Nadu; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof, district-wise for women, men and persons with disabilities alongwith the ongoing and upcoming initiatives of the Government to promote Digital Literacy in the country?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR ELECTRONICS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI JITIN PRASADA)

(a) to (d):In order to improve the digital literacy rate, especially in rural India, the Government of India implemented a scheme titled "Pradhan Mantri Gramin Digital Saksharta Abhiyan (PMGDISHA)" to usher in digital literacy in rural India by covering 6 crore rural households (one person per household)which has been officially concluded on 31.03.2024.

As on 31st March 2024, around 7.35 crore candidates have been enrolled and 6.39 crore have been trained, out of which 4.78 crore candidates have been certified under the PMGDISHA Scheme. The State/UT-wise status of the scheme is given at Annexure I.

In the state of Tamil Nadu, a total of more than 17.04 Lakh candidates have been enrolled and 14.07 Lakh candidates have been trained, out of which 10.55 Lakh candidates have been duly certified under the PMGDISHA Scheme. Out of the total certification in Tamil Nadu, approximately 76 percent certified candidates are women and 24 percent candidates are men. The district-wise status for women, men and persons with disabilities in the State of Tamil Nadu under the PMGDISHA Scheme are given at Annexure II.
