STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 73 FOR 26TH JULY, 2024

(a) to (e): Government Medical College(GMC), Dungarpur was approved under Phase-I of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) for 'Establishment of new medical colleges attached with existing district/referral hospitals' in the year 2014 at a cost of Rs.189 crores to be shared between Centre and State Government in the ratio of 60:40. Entire Central Share of Rs.113.40 crore has been released to Government of Rajasthan. The college became functional with intake capacity of 100 MBBS seats in 2018. As informed by the State Government, no inconvenience to patients is found.
