REMEDIES FOR TRAFFIC PROBLEMS

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) Whether the Government has called for urgent and effective remedies for growing traffic problems across the cities in the country and if so, the details thereof and the solutions chalked out in this regard;
- (b) Whether it is true that many of the recently constructed flyovers are not in usage for public transport; and
- (c) If so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF SATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI TOKHAN SAHU)

(a) to (c) Traffic planning is part of urban planning which is a State subject. As such, planning and management of traffic is done by the respective State Governments/ Union Territories (UTs)/ Urban Local Bodies (ULBs). However, this Ministry has issued National Urban Transport policy (NUTP) 2006 and National Transport Oriented Development (TOD) policy which are guidance documents for Cities/States/UTs to adopt sustainable measure to deal with various transport related issues.
