- (a) whether the Government has recently undertaken any survey/study regarding the employment opportunities in rural areas of the country;**
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the number of individuals who have migrated from rural areas to urban areas in search of employment during the last five years, State-wise, especially from the State of Andhra Pradesh;**
- (c) whether the Government has introduced any schemes/projects/initiatives for increasing employment opportunities in rural areas and if so, the details thereof;**
- (d) the total number of beneficiaries of such schemes/projects/initiatives during the last five years, State-wise; and**
- (e) whether the Government has taken/proposes to take any steps for introduction of job-fairs, employment portals and other such events/programmes to provide jobs to youths in rural areas and if so, the details thereof including the total number of such events during the last five years in the State of Andhra Pradesh, especially in Eluru and Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Konaseema districts?**

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**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (e) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. \*85 DUE FOR REPLY ON 29.07.2024 BY SHRI PUTTA MAHESH KUMAR, SHRI G M HARISH BALAYOGI REGARDING “EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES IN RURAL AREAS”**

**(a) to (e): The data on Employment and Unemployment is collected through Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) which is conducted by the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI) since 2017-18. The survey period is July to June every year.**

**As per the data available in latest Annual PLFS Reports, the estimated Worker Population Ratio (WPR), indicating employment, including rural areas, on usual status for persons of age 15 years and above during 2020-21 to 2022-23 were as follows:**

**The above data indicates that the employment has increasing trend in the country.**

**The Ministry of Labour and Employment has launched eShram portal, on 26th August, 2021. The main objective of the eShram portal is to create a national database of unorganized workers, including migrant workers seeded with Aadhaar. As on 24.07.2024, around 29.83 crore unorganised workers, including migrant workers have registered in this portal. The State-wise details (including Andhra Pradesh) are at Annexure I.**

**Employment generation coupled with improving employability is the priority of the Government. Accordingly, the Government of India has taken various steps for generating employment in the country.**

**The various Ministries/ Departments of Government of India like Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises, Ministry of Rural Development, Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs, Ministry of Finance, Ministry of Textile, Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology etc. are implementing different employment generation schemes/ programmes like Aatmanirbhar Bharat Rojgar Yojana (ABRY), Pradhan Mantri Rojgar Protsahan Yojana (PMRPY), Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS), Pt. Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY), Rural Self Employment and Training Institutes (RSETIs), Deen Dayal Antodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM), Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana (PMMY), etc. including increase in capital expenditure to boost employment creation. The details of various employment generation schemes/programmes being implemented by the Government of India may be seen at [https://dge.gov.in/dge/schemes\\_programmes](https://dge.gov.in/dge/schemes_programmes). The State/UT-wise details of beneficiaries in ABRY, PMRPY, PMEGP, MGNREGA, DDU-GKY and RSETIs including rural areas are at Annexure II-VII.**

**Ministry of Labour and Employment is implementing the National Career Service (NCS) project to provide all career related services like job search and matching, career counselling, vocational guidance, information on skill development courses etc. through a digital platform [www.ncs.gov.in]. Till 30.06.2024, total 11.37 lakh jobseekers have registered on NCS from Andhra Pradesh since 2015.**

**Job fair is one of the steps towards fulfillment of the commitment of the Government to accord highest priority to employment generation amongst youth. Regular Job Fairs are being organized under various schemes by the State Governments/ Ministries/ Departments etc. As per information received from State Employment Exchanges/Model Career Centres on NCS, 2783 job fairs have been conducted in the State of Andhra Pradesh during 2019-20 to 2023-24.**
