(a) & (b): With a view to make the basic fares more affordable and to provide the passengers an option of paying for the services which he/she wishes to avail Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) has issued Air Transport Circular (ATC) 01 of 2024 titled "Unbundle of services and fees by scheduled airlines" to allow some of the services to be unbundled and charged separately on opt-in basis, which includes meal/snack/drink charges (except drinking water).
