## Regarding issues concerning Southern States particularly Kerala

**SHRI TEJASVI SURYA (BANGALORE SOUTH):** Hon. Chairperson Sir, I would want to seek your permission to raise an issue concerning the southern States in general and Kerala in particular.

Over the last few days, unfortunately, the landslides in Wayanad have taken away the lives of more than 160 innocent people. Over the last five years, more than 350 people have died due to landslides, disasters and accidents in Kerala. The unbridled and unregulated economic and commercial activities, including quarrying and mining in eco-sensitive areas of the Western Ghats are the primary reasons for this. Many reports were submitted earlier which were rejected successively by the UDF and the LDF Governments in Kerala in the last so many years. ? (*Interruptions*)

So, from the Government side, we also agree to discuss this issue. ....(Interruptions) We went to the hon. Speaker, who agreed to provide time for discussion under Calling Attention today. That is what I was informed. Our hon. Member is not aware of that because the decision was taken very late. That is why I would like to inform that discussion on this matter under Calling Attention is already agreed upon. The discussion will start either at 3 o?clock or 4 o?clock. This will be informed to the hon. House accordingly.

SHRI K. C. VENUGOPAL (ALAPPUZHA): Yesterday, this issue was raised by the hon. Leader of the Opposition. There is no word to express the tragedy which happened in Wayanad, Kerala. People are still trapped. Not many bodies have been recovered. We do not want to politicise this issue. That is why we wanted a response from the Government yesterday itself. We already told that we want a response from the Government.

The people of the State Government, Central Government agencies and all the NGOs are doing rescue work. ....(Interruptions)

That means, a mosquito will try to suck blood even from a cow?s udder oozing with milk.
