

Regarding NEET-UG, UGC-NET and NEET-PG examinations- Laid

SHRI S. VENKATESAN (MADURAI): There are disturbing developments in respect of the centralized all India examination processes one after another i.e. NEET-UG, UGC-NET and now NEET-PG which has been postponed indefinitely. There are serious irregularities which raise questions on the systemic issues of the Government policies on higher education such as Centralization, Commercialization and Communalization in the education sphere though the issue of corruption only has come to limelight. In fact, the full dimension of it comes under the purview of the National Education Policy which needs to be reviewed. This house has to discuss fixing accountability and stern action against people responsible at all levels in the Ministry and NTA, reversal of centralization of governance of higher education, scrapping the centralized NEET exams which has been the consistent demand of Tamil Nadu and supported by other states also now, entrusting the job to States to evolve their own procedures for admission into professional educational institutions etc.
