### Modernisation of Automatic Exchanges in Bihar

- (a) the number of digital trunk and automatic exchanges modernised in Dumka, Godda, Deodhar, Banka and Jamui districts of Bihar;
- (b) the number of STD telephones set in order and the number of new STD telephones installed:
- (c) the procedure of providing STD/ISD and PCO facility in rural areas;
- (d) the number of solar energy telephones set up in rural areas of above districts which are functioning; and
- (e) the number of such telephones proposed to be installed?

THE MINISTER OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI BENI PRASAD VARMA): (a) There are no digital trunk exchanges in Dumka, Godda, Deodhar, Banka and Jamui District of Bihar.

The number of automatic exchanges modernised in above Districts is given below:

Dumka: 13; Godda: 8; Deodhar: 7; Banka: 10 and Jamui: 11 only.

(b) The performance of the STD payphones is closely monitored. The number of STD payphones installed in the places mentioned above are:

Dumka: 32; Godda: 10; Deodhar: 67; Banka: 5 and Jamui: 9.

- (c) The STD/ISD payphones are allotted on the basis of the recommendations of a Committee set up for the purpose. Village PCOs are installed in places easily accessible to the Public.
- (d) Number of Solar energy telephones set up in rural areas districtwise which are functioning are :-

Dumka: 95; Godda: 24; Deodhar: 20; Banka: 129 and Jamui: 90.

(e) The number of solar energy telephones proposed to be installed districtwise during 1996-97 are :

Dumka: 12; Godda: 7; Deodhar: 24; Banka: 102 and Jamui: 12.

# Increase in the Relay Capacity of Jaipur Doordarshan Kendra

- 914 SHRI GIRDHARI LAL BHARGAVA: Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:
- (a) whether the Government propose to increase the relay capacity of Jaipur Doordarshan Kendra, Rajasthan;
- (b) if so, the time by which it is likely to be increased;
- (c) whether the programmes of the Jaipur Doordarshan Kendras can be viewed in the entire State; and
  - (d) if not, the efforts being made in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF CIVIL AVIATION AND MINISTER OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI C.M. IBRAHIM): (a) and (b) There is no proposal, at present, to increase the power of the existing High Power TV Transmitter (HPT) at Jaipur.

(c) and (d) Whereas the regional service originating from Doordarshan Kendra, Jaipur is available throughout the country including the entire State of Rajasthan, via satellite, by using an appropriate dish antennae system, the service is being relayed terestrially by all the HPTs and LPTs in the State.
