(a) whether the Jalna-Khamgaon Railway line in Maharashtra is being delayed in spite of technical clearance given by the Government;

(b) if so, the reasons therefor; and

(c) the steps proposed to be taken by the Government for immediate completion of the same?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI SATPAL MAHARAJ) : (a) No, Sir. It is not a sanctioned project.

Printing of Railway Tickets in Regional Language

(a) whether card tickets and seasons tickets for sub-urban and main line passengers of the Central Railway are not printed in Marathi alongwith English and Hindi; and

(b) if so, reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI SATPAL MAHARAJ) : (a) and (b). Card Tickets for suburban and Mail Line passengers of Central Railway are printed in Marathi alongwith Hindi and English. However, Seasons tickets on Central Railway are printed in Hindi and English only. Due to limitation of space, it is not possible to print all the particulars in trilingual form on the Season Tickets without compressing material drastically. This would render the printed matter the illegible and is, therefore, not desirable.

Halt-Stations for Rajdhani Express

2191. SHRI YELLAIAH NANDI : Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state :

(a) whether the Government are aware that a Rajdhani Express has been operating from New Delhi via Madras-Bangalore-Hyderabad;

(b) whether Government are also aware that the said Rajdhani Express has a very few halts on its route whereby it fails to accommodate current rush of passengers at all the major railway stations;

(c) whether the Government are contemplating to provide the train with a few more halts at the major stations with a view to solve the travelling needs of the public; and

(d) if so, the details thereof and the time by which the halts so needed are likely to be provided by the Government?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI SATPAL MAHARAJ) : (a) and (b). Weekly Rajdhani Expresses/Special are running between Hazrat Nizamuddin and Madras via Vijayawada, Hazrat Nizamuddin and Trivandrum via Madras and Hazrat Nizamuddin and Bangalore via Secunderabad with minimum intermediate stoppages.
