- (a) the amount so far spent on the cleaning of river Ga.:ga;
- (b) the work so far completed and the work left over under the Ganga Action Plan, State wise: and
- (c) the extent of pollution removed from the Ganga Water, State wise?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT AND FOR-ESTS (SHRI KAMAL NATH): (a) An amount of Rs. 256.18 crores has so far been spent under the Ganga Action Plan.

- (b) A statement showing State wise list of scheme completed and under progress is given in the attached statement.
- (c) As a result of completed schemes, 405 million litres per day (mld) of Waste water has been diverted against a total target of 873mld. Waste water diverted accounts for 295mld in Uttar Pradesh, 27mld in Bihar and 83 mld in West Bengal. Wherever diversion and pollution abatement works have been completed, there is an indiction of improvement in the water quality of the river.
